for the approximately 130 home-  
less individuals who came to New  
Visions to escape the heat and  
cold, the rain and snow. The  
homeless also came to New Vi-  
sions to eat breakfast and lunch,  
to take showers, to do laundry  
and to get their mail. We hope  
this situation will be temporary  
and that other homeless providers  
will eventually find the space and  
finances needed to provide these  
important services. IHOC will also  
be looking for new office space in
